

Camino Inglés

Ferrol → Santiago de Compostela · 6 stages · 112 km

The Camino Inglés is the shortest route that qualifies for the Compostela: 113 km from Ferrol through estuaries, forests and inland villages of A Coruña. Ideal for a week and very quiet outside summer.

When to go

All year; it is the rainiest route, bring a rain jacket. May, June and September are the best months.

Getting to the start

Ferrol has trains and buses from A Coruña and Santiago; the nearest airport is A Coruña.

The Compostela and the last 100 km

From Ferrol you cover 113 km. From A Coruña it is only 75 km, which is not enough unless topped up in your home city.

The long stage

Betanzos – Hospital de Bruma (28.7 km) is the hardest; it can be split at Presedo or Vizoño.
